## Syrah Vin de Pays D'Oc 2006

Our estate-bottled Syrah is from a domain in the coastal Garrigues of the Languedoc which has been run by the same family since the end of the 19th century. Today, the fifth generation continues the tradition of producing authentic wines that reflect their terroir. This is a robust, yet easy-to-drink red, expressive of the Garrigues.
